## Introduction to 2015 ICPA (11th)

2015 公共管理国际会议(第十一届) 由电子科技大学、《中国行政管理》杂志社、美国行政管理学会和印度 尼西亚巴查查兰大学共同主办,电子科技大学区域公共管理信息化研究中心、南非开普半岛科技大学共同协办,电 子科技大学政治与公共管理学院和印度尼西亚巴查查兰大学社会与政治科学学院承办。

本届会议于 2015 年 12 月 9 日-11 日在印度尼西亚万隆巴查查兰大学举行。围绕本届会议主题"可持续发展与公共管理创新",国内外学者提交的会议论文共 603 篇,录用 308 篇,会议论文集由电子科技大学出版社公开出版。本届会议吸引了世界各地的公共管理领域专家、学者及实践者,与会代表近 200 人,主要来自中国、美国、俄罗斯、法国、南非、印度尼西亚、英国、德国、澳大利亚、新加坡、加拿大、比利时、荷兰、葡萄牙、波兰、印度、日本、韩国、菲律宾、索马里、毛里求斯、尼日利亚、文莱、越南、中国澳门等国家和地区。

本届会议由中国著名行政学家夏书章教授担任名誉主席,印度尼西亚巴查查兰大学副校长兼社会与政治科学学院院长 Arry Bainus 教授、中国行政管理学会副秘书长鲍静研究员、电子科技大学政治与公共管理学院院长祝小宁教授、美国行政管理学会主席(2015-2016) Maria Aristigueta 教授担任大会主席,美国联邦企业风险管理学会主席、约翰霍普金斯大学 Thomas H. Stanton 研究员担任学术委员会主席,美国行政管理学会执行主席 William Shields 先生、电子科技大学政治与公共管理学院赵蜀蓉教授、印度尼西亚巴查查兰大学社会与政治科学学院学术与学生事务副院长 Mudiyati Rahmatunnisa 博士担任大会执行主席。

本届会议特邀印度尼西亚地方政府研究院和国家审计署专属委员 Bahrullah Akbar 教授、北京大学政府管理学院 党委书记周志忍教授、约翰霍普金斯大学 Thomas H. Stanton 研究员,分别就印度尼西亚审计系统改革:基于可持续的金融系统构建、风险社会背景下的政府管理:发展中国家的挑战与前景、美国企业风险管理与政府联动做大会主题发言。

本届会议设定 6 个议题:公共管理可持续发展、善治与反腐、绩效管理和智慧政府、网络治理和电子政务、公共管理改革与创新、公共管理未来模式,并设置 6 个分会场,举行 18 场分组讨论。

本届会议特设中印公共治理专题研讨会,并邀请中国国家教育部哲学社会科学委员会委员、原东北大学副校长 娄成武教授、印度尼西亚内政部研究与发展司司长 Prabawa Eka Soesanta 博士,分别就中国国家治理的现状与趋势、印尼 Jokowi 政府区域自治改革进行专题发言。来自中国、印尼及其他国家和地区的专家、学者在"一带一路"战略视域下,共同探讨中印两国及其他国家在公共治理中所面临的问题与挑战、借鉴与比较各国公共治理的经验及改革成效。

# Introduction to 2015 ICPA (11th) —Sustainable Development for Public Administration

## 2015年公共管理国际会议——可持续发展与公共管理创新

"Sustainable development is development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of nations and their people to meet their needs over the long term." The financial crisis of 2007-2008 had multiple effects on countries across the globe and, by extension, on governmental organizations. Many governments found that their expenditures rose dramatically in faltering economies as revenues dropped. Exporting countries found that exports declined, sometimes drastically. The boom and bust cycle can be incredibly wasteful. The consequences for public administration are severe as well .While countries could afford expanding government services in boom times—prior to 2007-2008—troubled economies have led to serious pressure to cut back in many countries. Officials of national, state and local governments all have felt the pressure of budget uncertainty and serious budget constraints. This comes in the context of growing realization that resources are finite; we cannot simply consume scarce resources, and especially in ways that generate costly such unsustainable byproducts as pollution and climate change.

The 2015 conference seeks to address the problem of managing governmental organizations with an eye both to the short and longer term. For the short term, what can public administration teach policymakers and government managers about sustaining public services in the face of sometimes severe economic and policy cycles? For the longer term, how should policymakers and government managers address the need to avoid less expensive short-term approaches to providing public services in favor of long-term more sustainable approaches?

The *Proceedings 2015 International Conference on Public Administration (11th)* encompasses a wide-ranging analysis and examination of excellence and innovation in public administration research and practice. The Proceedings contain a rich and broad collection of ideas and research findings directed at sustainable development for public administration. Authored by academics and practitioners worldwide, the collection promises to advance public administration research and practice. There are six sub-themes—Public Administration for Sustainable development, Good Governance, Performance and Smart Government, Networking and Partnerships and E-government, Public Management, Future in Public Administration.

The submissions of 2015 International Conference on Public Administration (11th) have amounted to Six Hundred and Three pieces from both China and abroad, including more than one hundred pieces submitted by foreign experts, scholars and practitioners to both School of Political Science and Public Administration of University of Electronic Science and Technology of China and American Society for Public Administration. 



Dr (HC) Ahmad Heryawan (Aher) was firstly elected as the Governor of West Java Province in 2008. He was re-elected for the same position in 2013, and will serve in the position until 2018. Within 6 years of his service in West Java, Governor Ahmad Heryawan won a total of 194 awards for his achievements in managing the area. He received a Dr (HC) in Business Administration from Youngson University, Busan, South

Korea (2011). In his speech entitled "Business-based Public Policy Innovation", he argues that Business-based Public Policy Innovation is important to respond global challenges and to encourage local bussinesses in adapting themselves into strategic global, regional, national and local environments. He received 2nd award as Doctor Honoris Causa from Islamic University, Bandung in the area of Islamic Governance (Siyasah Syaríyyah) in 2014. His academic speech entitled "Governance Paradigm Transformation Towards Highly Competitive Society". His career in politics began when he joined the Justice Party (Partai Keadilan, now the Prosperous Justice Party, Partai Keadilan Sejahtera). He was elected as a member of the Jakarta provincial legislature in 1999. After the 2004 election, Ahmad Heryawan served as Vice Chairman of the Parliament of Jakarta 2004-2009.

Program gets Indonesia MDG's Award in 2013. Besides being active as a researcher, Prof. Tri is also a frequent speaker at national and international conferences.

He brings to the position more than 15 years of executive and management experience in the non-profit sector, most recently as Vice President of the National Low Income Housing Coalition, the leading U.S. public policy organization dedicated to ensuring that people with the lowest incomes have affordable homes. For more than a decade, Shields held senior management and

research positions at the Washington, DC-based National Academy of Public Administration, a congressionally chartered organization established to assist government leaders in building effective, efficient, accountable and transparent organizations.

As Vice President, he worked extensively with the Academy's 500 elected Fellows, the top U.S. leaders in the study and practice of public administration. He served on research teams studying organization and management issues at the U.S. Departments of Defense, Housing and Urban Development, and Transportation. He edited more than 50 Academy panel reports on issues ranging from federal government compensation issues to reorganization of U.S. intelligence organizations. Shields served as Director at the Chief Executives Organization, a non-profit organization of 2,000 chief executives around the world, and in the Executive Office of the Mayor of Providence, Rhode Island.

Born in 1919, Professor Xia Shu-zhang is a distinguished scholar in Public Administration. Mr. Xia is one of the core founders of contemporary Public Administration in China and is also regarded as the "Father of

Chinese MPA". He is the honorary president, professor Ph.D. supervisor of School of

Government of Sun Yat-Sen University. Mr. Xia graduated from School of Law of National Central University and Harvard University in USA. He has been working as a professor in Sun Yat-Sen University since 1947. Mr. Xia was conferred the Outstanding Achievement Award by EROPA, and was awarded the "Outstanding Achievement Award in International Public Administration" by The American Society for Public Administration in 2006 and other internationally and nationally recognized awards as well.

Association of Federal Enterprise Risk Management (AFERM) ,USA Thomas H. Stanton

Thomas H. Stanton is President of the Association of Federal Enterprise Risk Management (AFERM) and served for many years as a board member of the National Academy of Public Administration (NAPA), and as Chair of the NAPA Standing Panel on Executive Organization and Management. He served as a member of the federal Senior Executive Service for almost five years.

Mr. Stanton teaches as an adjunct faculty member at the Center for Advanced Governmental Studies at the Johns Hopkins University, where he received the award for Excellence in Teaching. He teaches the program's core course for the MBA/MA in Government, and a graduate seminar on governance, risk management, and the financial markets. Many US Government agencies have requested his services to help provide analyses relating to the design and administration of federal government programs. Mr. Stanton has been an invited witness before many congressional committees and subcommittees.

Mr. Stanton was a graduate teaching assistant at Yale University in Southeast Asian history and has maintained a strong interest in law and development. He published, "Law and Economic Development: The

Cautionary Tale of Colonial Burma," Asian Journal of Law and Society, January 2014. He has published two articles in Chinese journals and has been a frequent international speaker and consultant, including for the Instituto Libertad y Democracia (ILD) of Lima, Peru, the Home Mortgage Bank of Trinidad and Tobago, the U.S. Agency for International Development for the State Property Fund of the Kyrgyz Republic, and the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (to review operations of the European Patent Office). In 1998 he was invited to present two papers on corporate governance to the China Institute for Reform and Development (Hainan) and in 2004 he was part of an OECD delegation to advise the Chinese government on reforming the delivery of public services. In March 2013 he was invited as a guest to participate in a conference on the financial crisis at the KoGuan Law School of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University and to speak at other universities in Shanghai and Hong Kong.

Lou Cheng-wu, male, born in Beijing City, Liaoning Province in May, 1949, is a professor, doctoral supervisor, and member of the Communist Party of China. Professor Lou began his teaching in Northeastern University after graduation in 1975, and initiated the major of administrative management there in 1993. With his relentless efforts, this discipline has become first-rate nationwide. Currently, he

serves as the director of Northeastern Division of National Science and Technology Policy Research Center and Northeastern University Science and Technology Policy Research Center which is a strategic research center of the Ministry of Education. Furthermore, he is member of the Ministry of Education Philosophy and Social Science Committee, the State Council Academic Degree Office MPA Expert Committee, as well as the council of Chinese Public Administration Society.

Starting his academic research of politics and public administration as early as the 1980s, he has made great contributions to the teaching and academic study of public administration in China. His studies have laid a solid foundation for the further development of the theoretical research on public management in China. Professor Lou put forward several famous views on China's social security system, salary system reform, labor allocation system, public service system, and leading cadre assessment in 1985 which were all adopted by the Chinese government later on

In recent years, he undertakes over 30 major research projects under the auspices of the Ministry of Education, National Development and Reform Commission, and Liaoning Province Social Science Fund, etc. He has published more than 120 academic papers on journals at home and abroad and over 20 books or textbooks. He was awarded as China Distinguished Teacher.

He has published widely in the field of public administration covering government performance management, comparative study of government innovation and reform, public participation and accountability, and functional restructuring and reorganization of Chinese Governments in the reform period. In the names of chief investigator or principal domestic consultant, he presided over 8 joint projects sponsored by UNDP, OECD, or ADB.or several times and the Outstanding Social Scientist of China in 2007 and 2008.



#### INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

Unpad now has collaboration with 135 International partners from 35 countries spreaded in Asia, Australia, Europe, America, and Africa. There are about 1170 international students mostly studying in the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy, Indonesian Language, Legal Study, etc.

#### SCHOLARSHIP

Financial assistance is available to Unpad's students who experience economic difficulties. The funds are made possible through government and private agencies, the industrial community foundations and various other donors. Priority is given to students who demonstrate seriousness in study but having limitations in meeting living costs and/or tuition fees. Students may apply for scholarship through the Vice Dean of Student Affairs in their respective faculties by fulfilling the necessary requirements. For international students, Ministry of Research, Technology And Higher Education Republic Of Indonesia offers scholarship for Master and Doctoral Programs i.e. KNB Scholarship (Scholarship for Developing Country Partnership) and Scholarship for Indonesian Language, art and culture studies called Darmasiswa Program Scholarship consisting 3, 6, or 12 month program. In addition, through University to University partnership program, Unpad also offers scholarship covering tuition fee, then the scholars can look for sponsorship of living allowance and accommodation fee.






